iPathology 24-hour Workflow

- 3:30pm – 5pm
iPathology couriers pick up specimens from physicians' offices.
- 6pm – 7pm
Specimens arrive at iPathology for accessioning and processing.
- 7pm – 9pm
Specimens are accessioned, grossed, recorded and put on processors for fixation (6hr. process).
- 9pm – 11pm
All work including patient demographics and gross description are transcribed.
- 3am – 4am
Specimens are removed from 6hr. process and prepared for embedding.
- 4am – 5am
Paraffin blocks are embedded.
- 5am – 7am
Paraffin blocks are cut and slides are prepared for staining.
- 7am – 9am
Slides are stained and cover slipped.
- 9am – 11am
Slides are read / diagnosed by pathologist
- 11am – 12pm
Diagnoses are transcribed
- 12pm – 1pm
Final Reports are distributed to physicians' offices.
